WILL SCOTT BRINGS HIS BRAND OF SOUL-AMERICANA AND BLUES ON TOUR FROM NEW YORK

*New-York-City-based artist, Will Scott, will be on tour in the Southeast and Midwest in November 2009 supporting his new album release *Gnawbone*.*

BODY:

Acclaimed, New York-based, roots music songwriter WILL SCOTT will be on tour in the Southeast and Midwest US, from November 1 to November 13, 2009 in support of his new CD release, *Gnawbone*. The tour launches in Washington, D.C. and includes dates in Virginia, North Carolina, Tennessee, Kentucky, Indiana, and Ohio. SCOTT will be performing on guitar and vocals, accompanied by Wylie Wirth on drums.

WILL SCOTT is known for his mix of soulful Americana, Rock and Blues as well as for his powerful voice that The New York Press describes as “thick as blood.” His energetic live performances have helped to build him a loyal audience in the US and the UK (“best weekly blues show in New York” -- Lucid Culture).

Originally from Indiana, SCOTT, lived in Bloomington for eight years where he performed with The Forecasters and other bands. He shows his Hoosier roots on his new album with two songs inspired by Indiana towns, *Gnawbone* and *Jack’s Defeat Creek*. The album also features guest performances by Jolie Holland (ANTI- Records), Samantha Parton (Be Good Tanyas), and Jan Bell (The Maybelles). Alt. Blues and Americana innovator, Preacher Boy (Blind Pig Records, Eagle Eye Cherry), who produced the album, is also featured on guitar, organ, piano, mandolin, and other instruments. Martin Dowsing describes *Gnawbone* in the London Evening Standard as “an astonishingly assured blend of sophisticated songwriting and soulful vocals... backed up by a crack team of hand-picked musicians.”

This tour comes on the heels of SCOTT’s extensive West Coast US and UK tours this summer, including a debut performance at the Glastonbury Festival in June 2009. You can catch WILL SCOTT at the venues listed on the following pages.
